Homeless shelters in the United States are usually operated by a non-profit agency or a municipal agency, or are associated with a church. They almost always have board members pulled from various sectors of the community including clergy, elected officials, and heads of volunteer groups.

Homeless shelters often provide other services to the community at large. The classic example is the soup kitchen for persons who are not staying at the shelter. Others include support groups, and/or substance abuse treatment. If they do not offer any of these services, they can usually refer their clients to agencies that do. Supportive housing integrates services in a more assertive fashion. The typical pathway through the interlocking system is that a person may start in a shelter and move through transitional housing into supportive housing and finally independent housing.

Centers in the United States are also often coordinated with outside programs both for their mission-specific operations and for other services. For communication of their availability, most centers coordinate with a phone information system which allows needy persons to find out where shelters are located. For transportation to shelters, some offer free transportation.
