When is something considered “worth it”? When we classify a reward or outcome as something worth doing or making an effort to work towards, we are basically saying that the situation’s _____.

This is also why our opinion of what is ‘worth doing’ is not always an objective thing. Take climbing a mountain, for example. The act of doing so is not only tiring but often perilous, and so many things could go wrong as you scale that slope. A lot of people wouldn’t take that risk for what they perceive to be the sole reward: reaching the top of the mountain. Still, there are a number of people in this world who would take on that challenge. Maybe that outcome is something that, to these few people, is valuable. Or, perhaps they see more exciting rewards that trump the many risks: the breaking of a record, perhaps, or feeling a rare adrenaline rush.

Studies show that there is, in fact, a biological factor that makes gossip more than just the sharing of juicy details. The act of sharing gossip is _____ such grooming in primates. Both acts create a sense of intimacy and trust between those in the group; when we gossip with people, we are basically creating an in-group (the primates) that automatically determines an outgroup (the fleas) that can be analyzed or criticized (the act of picking the fleas out). People who we share gossip feel like we trust them, which, in turn, usually gets them to trust us back. This is why friend groups that are close are often known to gossip together; they all feel they can trust each other not just with their own secrets but with those of others.
